## **Public Service Commission Continues Process to Release Kemper Documents**

**[JACKSON, MISS]**-Earlier this year, the Public Service Commission (PSC) began a process to begin the unveiling of certain confidential documents regarding the Kemper Power Plant Project.

Since then, the PSC has continued with its efforts to unseal documents filed confidentially in the original case that certificated the Kemper Project. Although the law requires that companies be given an opportunity to identify and protect commercially and financially sensitive documents, the PSC intends to place burden on the parties involved in Kemper to identify documents filed confidentially and their justification for doing so.

Executive Secretary of the PSC will give proper notice to parties involved that certain documents will be made public. The notified parties will then have the opportunity to assert their justification for their confidential filing of the documents while ultimately, a court must decide any disputes about designations of confidentiality.
