Presley to Hold Public Hearing Regarding 4-County Substation in Oktibbeha County

Nettleton, Mississippi (December 15, 2017) – Northern District Public Service Commissioner Brandon Presley announced today that he will hold a public hearing regarding a request 4-County to construct a new substation in Oktibbeha County. This substation will be known as the Bluefield Substation. The substation will be located southwest of Starkville and cost approximately three million dollars.

The public hearing will be held on Wednesday, December 20, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. The hearing will take place at the Oktibbeha Chancery Court located at 101 East Main Street in Starkville, MS.
