**Chairman Maxwell Announces Slight Rate Decrease for Mississippi Power Customers**

*This slight reduction marks the third decrease since Maxwell took office*

(JACKSON, MS) – During its open meeting on September 1, 2020, Chairman Dane Maxwell and fellow Public Service Commissioners unanimously voted to approve a slight rate decrease for Mississippi Power customers. This reduction is the third for Mississippi Power customers since Maxwell took office in January 2020.

“Any time we can reduce rates for customers, I consider it an accomplishment,” Chairman Maxwell said. “We’ve worked hard over the past eight months to put downward pressure on all of the utility rates and we will continue to do so.”

This rate decrease will result in approximately 2 cents per 1000 kWh for residential customers serviced by Mississippi Power.

Customers can expect to see the decrease reflected in the October billing cycle.
