## NOTICE OF INITIAL PUBLIC WORKSHOP

Entergy Mississippi, LLC ("Entergy Mississippi", "EML," or the "Company") files its Notice of Initial Public Workshop ("Workshop") pursuant to Rule 29 of the Mississippi Public Service Commission and Public Utilities Staff's Public Utilities Rules of Practice and Procedure ("Procedural Rules" "Rules" or "RP"). Within this Notice, EML submits the day and time of its Workshop, to be held in the Commission's hearing room in Jackson, Mississippi as prescribed in Rule 29.

- 1. On November 22, 2019, the Mississippi Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued its Final Order Amending Rule 29 of its Procedural Rules, approving an Integrated Resource Planning and Reporting Rule ("IRP Rule" or "Rule 29"). The IRP Rule establishes resource planning reporting requirements and deadlines for electric utilities like Entergy Mississippi. The issuance of the Final Order triggered the provisions of Rule 29.105.2, requiring each electric utility subject to Rule 29 to "notice and conduct an initial public workshop for interested parties" within 30 days of filing its Notice of IRP Cycle.
- 2. On May 12, 2023, EML filed its Notice of IRP Cycle ("Notice"). In the Notice, EML requested that the Commission approve a modified schedule, including that EML conduct its public workshop no later than August 15, 2023.

3. On June 26, 2023, the Commission granted EML's request for an extension of time,

approving a modified schedule. Among other schedule modifications, the Commission ordered

EML to hold its public workshop no later than August 15, 2023.

4. The Company proposes to conduct its Initial Public Workshop on Wednesday,

August 9, 2023, between the hours of 9:00am and 12:00pm. This Workshop will be conducted in

the Commission's hearing room on the first floor of the Woolfolk State Office Building, located

at 501 N. West Street, Jackson, Mississippi 39201.

6. For the reasons stated above, EML requests that the Commission, acting through

its Executive Secretary, post the day and time noticed by EML to conduct its Initial Public
