- ✓ Plan a Primary & Secondary Evacuation Route
- ✓ Identify a Local Radio Station to Stay Up to Date
- ✓ Identify a Primary Shelter and Backup (if needed)
- ✓ Make a List of Emergency Contacts
- ✓ Make a List of Utility Contacts (Power/Water/Gas)
- ✓ Know How to Turn Off Utilities in Case of Evacuation
- ✓ Have a Plan in Place for Your Pets
- ✓ Stay Aware of Potential Hurricane Threats
- ✓ Monitor Official Forecasts & Review Plans
