IN RE: MISSISSIPPI POWER COMPANY'S NOTICE OF INITIAL PUBLIC WORKSHOP PURSUANT TO COMMISSION RULE 29

NOTICE OF INITIAL PUBLIC WORKSHOP RESCHEDULE

1. Mississippi Power Company ("MPC" or the "Company") files this Notice to Reschedule its Initial Public Workshop ("Workshop") pursuant to the Commission's Rule 29: Integrated Resource Planning and Reporting.

2. On November 22, 2019, the Commission issued its Final Order Amending Rule 29 to Establish Integrated Resource Planning and Annual Energy Delivery Reporting Requirements. The issuance of the Final Order triggered the provisions of Rule 29.105.2, requiring each electric utility subject to Rule 29 to "notice and conduct an initial public workshop for interested parties" within 30 days of filing its Notice of IRP Cycle.

3. On April 3, 2026, MPC filed its Notice of IRP Cycle, proposing to conduct its Initial Public Workshop on Wednesday, April 15, 2026, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m., in the Commission's hearing room in Jackson, Mississippi. On April 14, 2026, MPC filed a Notice to Postpone the Public Workshop

4. Following the filing of the Notice of IRP Cycle and the associated Workshop notice, an intervenor to MPC's IRP docket informed the Company that they

had not received notice of the filing. To ensure full participation by all interested parties and to maintain the transparency and inclusiveness intended by Rule 29, MPC proposes to reset the date of the Initial Public Workshop.

5. As stated in IRP Rule Section 105(2), “[th]e purpose of the initial public workshop is for the electric utility and interested parties to exchange pertinent information concerning the IRP process, such as resource options, planning assumptions and inputs that may be used in the development of a utility’s Integrated Resource Plan.” IRP Rule, Section 105(2).

6. MPC proposes to conduct its Initial Public Workshop on Tuesday, April 28, 2026, between the hours of 9:00am and 12:00pm. This Workshop will be conducted in the Commission’s hearing room on the first floor of the Woolfolk State Office Building, located at 501 N. West Street, Jackson, Mississippi 39201.

8. For the reasons stated above, MPC requests that the Commission, acting through its Executive Secretary, post the day and time noticed by MPC to conduct its Initial Public Workshop as prescribed in Rule 29.105.2.
