include all electrical and mechanical connections necessary to make system functional. Electrical p	ower
shall be furnished by Owner for life of this contract. All installation must be by an installer approv	ed by
the Utility.	
After installation has been performed, the Owner will assume the operation and maintenant	ce of
the equipment. The Owner shall be responsible for any cost associated with equipment failure. The C	wner
shall not pump solids, grease, or other particles into the Villages Utility Company, LLC sewer system	n that
are not characteristic of typical "domestic" sewer discharge. Should damages to the sewer system occ	ur as
a result of improper discharge activities by the Owner, which affect Utility sewer system, the Utility	shall
correct promptly and repairs shall be billed to the Owner. The Utility shall have right of access t	o the
Owner's sewer service equipment at all times necessary to make emergency repairs as a result of failu	ire of
the Owner to make any such repairs. Failure to pay for repairs made by the Utility within five (5)	days
shall be cause for discontinuation of service in accordance with Rule 8A of the Mississippi Public Se	rvice
Commission's Rules and Regulations Governing Public Utility Service.	
The Utility herein agrees to keep on hand a minimum of two (2) sewer pump service units fo	r use
in emergency situations.	
The Utility agrees to accept the sanitary sewer from the owner for a fee. The monthly fee pair	
the owner is per connection. If not received by the 10th day of the month, service	shall
be discontinued in accordance with Rule 8A of the Mississippi Public Service Commission's Rules	and
Regulations Governing Utility Service. Should service be discontinued, a reconnection fee	of
\$ shall be paid to reconnect. If service is discontinued, Owner shall be liable for all of	osts:
